Background

Children's emergency services are becoming busier and busier.

Birth rates from 2012-2019 increased by 8.9% in north western Melbourne and in 2020 there was a state-wide increase of 13% in Victoria's western health services.

An increase in the number of children with both short and longer-term conditions, including mental health problems, need a solution as there is a limit to how much emergency departments can grow.

So, hospitals around the world are looking at virtual or telehealth solutions which offer greater access for families without the need to always visit emergency departments.
